Our mission is to acquaint art lovers from all over the world with the rich culture and art of Central Asia and present regional artists with a special focus on Turkmenistan.

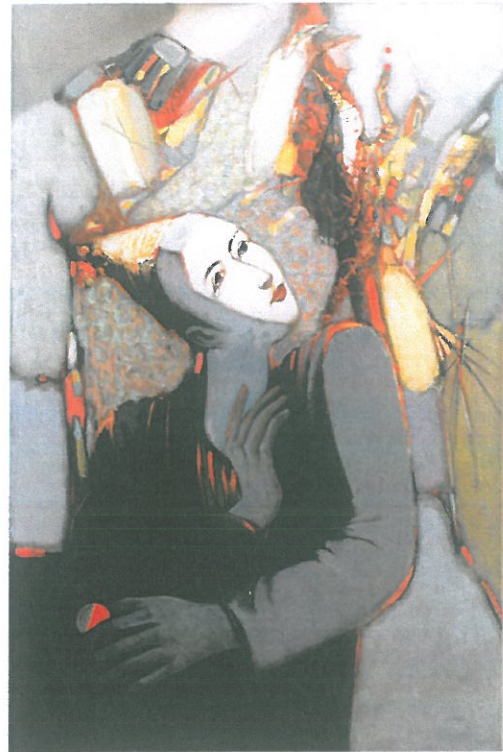

The history of contemporary Turkmen art is deeply affected by the historical development of this miraculous land. Turkmen culture at its core originates from the geometrical arrangement of color and shape of a carpet pattern, the austere and noble luxury of silver adornments, the generous richness of embroidery, the traditional domestic tools and decorations and the special customs and upbringing of local people.

Contemporary Turkmen art quickly grew out of the tight constraints of academism and broke free, splashing bright colors everywhere. Paintings of Turkmen artists embody all of the heat of the midday sun as well as the whisper of desert winds, the chant of birds and the natural contrasts of the home land.
