The development of education in the United Arab Emirates began in 1962, with more than 20 schools, with fewer than 4,000 students, mostly males. The infrastructure was not available for many basic social services such as hospitals, housing, airports, etc., and there was a great shortage of manpower. The publication of the printed press in the UAE and the Gulf region in general was delayed. The first printed newspaper was published in Makkah in 1908, Al-Hijaz newspaper. Kuwait newspaper was published in 1928 in Kuwait, about 100 years after the publication of the first Arabic newspaper, the Egyptian Chronicle, "published by Muhammad Ali in Egypt in 1828. There were more than two attempts by Emirati to issue newspapers or manuscripts here and there, where they relied on handwritten writing, between two basic phases: the period of written journalism and the period of print journalism. Although there is more than one study of the history of journalism in the UAE, it is difficult to rely on a single book or study to accurately follow the emergence of the press. There are still controversial points, such as the classification of some publications, whether they are newspapers or just manuscripts. In the period in which the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the then Ruler of Abu Dhabi, and his brothers the rulers of the other emirates, witnessed the establishment of the Union of the United Arab Emirates. Hence the name of the newspaper «Ittihad» to be the mouthpiece of the state as a unit entity, Al Ittihad was issued by the Department of Information and Tourism in Abu Dhabi and turned into a daily newspaper on April 20, 1972. Al Wahda newspaper was published on 16 August 1973 and is owned and edited by Rashid Oweida. On March 17, Al-Fajr newspaper owned by Obeid al-Mazroui was issued.


